

Royale Care - Adult Foster Care (AFC) Program



Want to be a Caregiver, and get paid while you take care of someone in your own home? That person could be your family member, friend or someone who is an elderly or disabled person, 16 years and over, that needs help with **one** or **more** Activities of Daily Living (ADLs) such as bathing, mobility, dressing, toileting and other elements of personal care, and also Instrumental Activities of Daily Living (IADLs) such as house cleaning, laundry, grocery shopping and medication reminders.

As an AFC Caregiver you are provided training support by Royale Care's AFC staff, and you will receive a tax-exempt, monthly stipend of (\$8,500 - \$18,000 per year) depending on whether the person needs level 1 or 2 care, and two weeks' paid vacation a year. You can have up to three **Level 1** or two **Level 2** cases in your home as long as each AFC member has an individual room; and there can be more than one Caregiver in the same home.

Family members can apply to become Caregivers **unless they are the parents** of a minor child who would be the AFC consumer, **the spouse** of the consumer, or a legally responsible relative (such as a **legal guardian**) of the consumer.
